19. Tanners Cava Brut, Traditional Method (Spain)

Fine and characterful, with aromas and flavours of lime, fruit blossom, biscuit and earth.

20. Prosecco Vino Frizzante, Veneto, Fabio Ceschin (Italy)

The Prosecco grapes for this wine are from the foothills of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene. The result is a gently sparkling wine with lovely peachy fruit, the palate is deliciously juicy with super balance. A great apéritif.

21. Rosè Vino Frizzante, Veneto, Fabio Ceschin (Italy)

A charming rosé full of soft raspberry fruit, the palate is light and full of sweet fruit then perfectly balanced with refreshing acidity.

22. Tanners Brut Extra Réserve Champagne (France)

A finely structured, fruit-driven style with an impression of white flowers, fleshy stone fruits and toast.

23. Moët et Chandon Brut Impérial (France)

Attractive and gently floral with green apples and citrus notes. Clean and fresh, with more apple and citrus fruit and an almost flinty character.

18. Prosecco Il Colle Borgo Frere, Frizzante, Treviso (Italy)

### Ladera Verde Sauvignon Blanc, Valle Central (Chile)

Crisp, fresh and zesty with bags of juicy lime citrus and melon fruit and a typical herbaceous character.

2. Cà Solare Pinot Grigio, Provincia di Pavia IGT (Italy)

With a crisp, dry, lightly floral character and a subtle honeyed note on the finish.

3. Wide River Chenin Blanc, Robertson (South Africa)

Clean and bright Chenin Blanc, peppery and aromatic, with tropical fruit flavours of ripe fig and melon backed up with crisp, refreshing acidity. Modern style wine from the fertile Robertson Valley.

4. Rioja Vega Blanco, Rioja (Spain)

A light fragrant Rioja made from the Viura grape variety. Youthful fruity citrus flavours with a fresh clean with hints of herbs on the finish, this is unoaked and juicy.

5. La Petite Vigne Chardonnay, IGP d'Oc (France)

Full of bright, lively pear and apple fruit on the nose with delicious citrus character on the palate. Succulent and fresh on the finish.

6. Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine des Lauriers, Coteaux du Languedoc (France)

Try this instead of your Chablis or Sauvignon. Fresh, lean, steely, mineral and bone dry. The perfect match for seafood.

7. Tummil Flat Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (New Zealand)

Classic Kiwi Sauvignon, fresh, crisp, full of gooseberry and nettle fruit with great poise and elegance.

8. Three Amigos Marsanne/Chardonnay/ Roussanne, Margaret River, McHenry Hohnen (Australia)

> A nutty, silky wine with creamy fruit and exotic hints. Full and well balanced with oak this is a good, interesting wine from David Hohnen.

9. Waters Edge White Zinfandel, California (USA)

Pale ruby-pink rosé with a red berry and peach bouquet.

### 10. Los Vilos Cabernet Sauvignon, Valle Central (Chile)

The delight of a simple, easy red is captured here in this superior, juicy Chilean. Full of blackcurrant fruit, soft and round in the mouth, with a rich feel on the finish. Chile boasts some of the most environmentally friendly vineyards in the world.

### 11. Jean Balmont Merlot, Vin de France (France)

Soft, fruity red with attractive black fruit flavours, fresh and juicy. Well made wine, with good length.

### 12. Wide River Shiraz, Robertson (South Africa)

Easy going, soft red with plenty of spicy, peppery fruit, this has good hedgerow berry flavours and power.

13. Château Malbat, Bordeaux (France)

An excellent petit château from the south-east end of Bordeaux near Langon. This is the rural farming rather than 'grand châteaux' part of Bordeaux and the wine reflects this in its easy-going and soft fruit style.

### 14. Chianti DOCG, Duca di Sasseta (Italy)

Soft and flavoursome Chianti with good depth, red fruit and easy tannins on the finish. This winery aims to produce modern style wines that are very drinkable.

15. Rioja Vega Crianza, Rioja (Spain)

The winery at Rioja Vega was overhauled in 2001 and their wines have surged forward. From Tempranillo with a little Mazuelo and Garnacha, this smooth, soft, richlyfruited red, has spice and vanilla from 12 months in American oak.

16. Malbec Reserva, Mendoza, Lurton (Argentina)

Full of smoky, spicy, black fruits, damson and Morello cherry, with good structure, balanced tannins and the sort of refinement you expect from top producers like the Lurton brothers.

17. Fleurie, André Colonge (France)

A floral, pretty nose is followed by a lush, ample palate with very juicy, strawberry fruit lifted by pleasant peppery notes. Three generations of the Colonge family are involved in this family estate.
